Of these incidents reported, the top three for middle schools include the following description categories: drugs/controlled substances (72), knives and other weapons (71), and fighting/attack on others (44).

Of these incidents reported, the top three for high schools include the following description categories: drugs/controlled substances (113), knives and other weapons (93), and fighting/attack on others (77).
